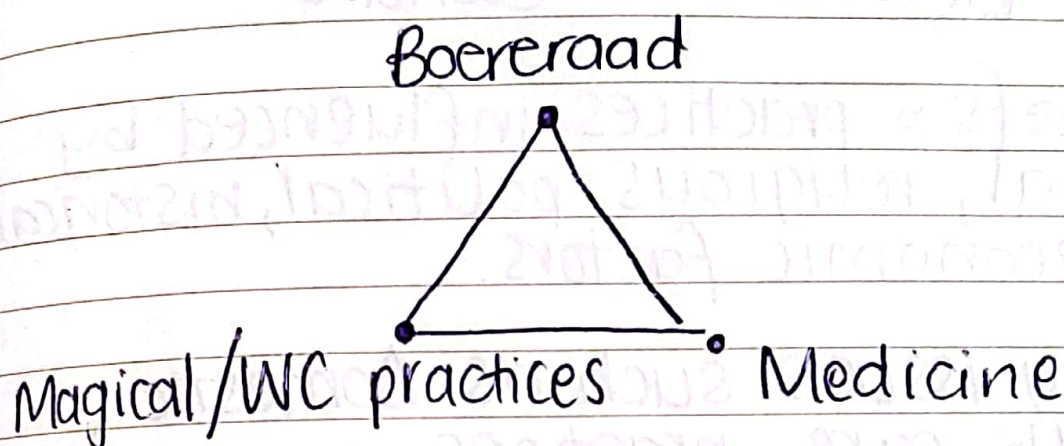

In Masters the issue of Boereraad was brought up in connection to witchcraft. More so it was treated by the witches as medical alternative.

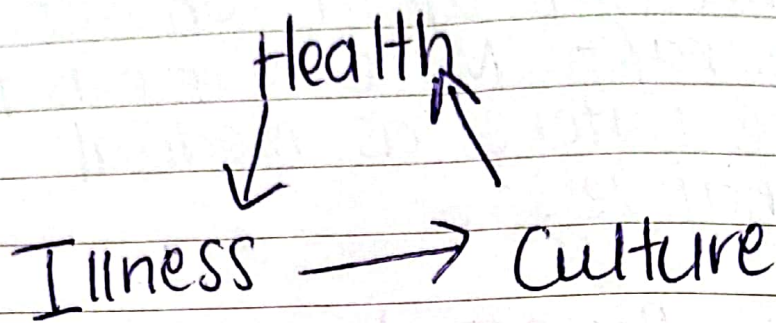
